**Project Overview** 

### **Project Scope**



The Ambulatory Role Delineation Project seeks to review and define clinical roles within Ambulatory Operations at UVA Health to create scope and competency standards across all clinics.

Ambulatory role delineation work was initiated at UVA Health over four years ago with reinvigorated support from Wendy Horton, UVA Medical Center Chief Executive Officer, and John Bennett, UVA Health Chief Ambulatory Operations Officer, in 2022.

### Why are we doing this?

- Lack of role definition and clarity has given rise to continuous requests for new job profiles.
- Results in more than 350 discreet job roles existing within Ambulatory Operations.
- Team member dissatisfaction due to frustration with job role clarity.
- Inability to work at top of and within appropriate scope of practice.
- To improve quality and safety of patient care, team member satisfaction, and enhance efficiency.



## Project Structure



#### Senior Leadership

Provides vision to project team, removes barriers, supports major decision-making.

#### Steering Committee

Recommends major decisions, provides input, guidance, champions a successful project and casts leadership messages. Meets regularly.

#### Project Leadership

Plans, designs, tracks and manages project. Raises key decisions, input and status. Leads work streams in frequent team meetings.


