

2023 Virginia Medicaid Reenrollment Talking Points for Team Members

To be shared with clinic and Access team members who interact with patients.

- During the pandemic, Medicaid members received continuous coverage, even if they were no longer eligible. With the sunset of the federal Covid-19 Public Health Emergency, Medicaid agencies are returning to normal enrollment processes. Starting in March 2023, Virginia will begin reviewing members' Medicaid coverage to make sure they still qualify.
- Virginia will not cancel or reduce coverage for members without asking for updated information, but they need help to make this a smooth process and ensure our patients maintain healthcare coverage.
- When engaging with a Medicaid member patient in the clinic, please point out the sign or give them a patient handout and review the following:
 - All Medicaid members should take steps now to make sure they receive information they'll need to renew Medicaid coverage.
 - Medicaid needs the most up to date mailing address, phone number, and email address to make sure members get important paperwork.
 - Contact information should be updated immediately by visiting commonhelp.virginia.gov or calling 855-242-8282.
 (Point out the QR code on the sign/patient handout and encourage them to scan it to go directly to commonhelp.virginia.gov. Many Medicaid members have smartphones as part of their membership.)
 - Medicaid members should respond quickly to any notices from Virginia Medicaid or other state agencies to ensure continuity of healthcare coverage.
